Local Rule (3)

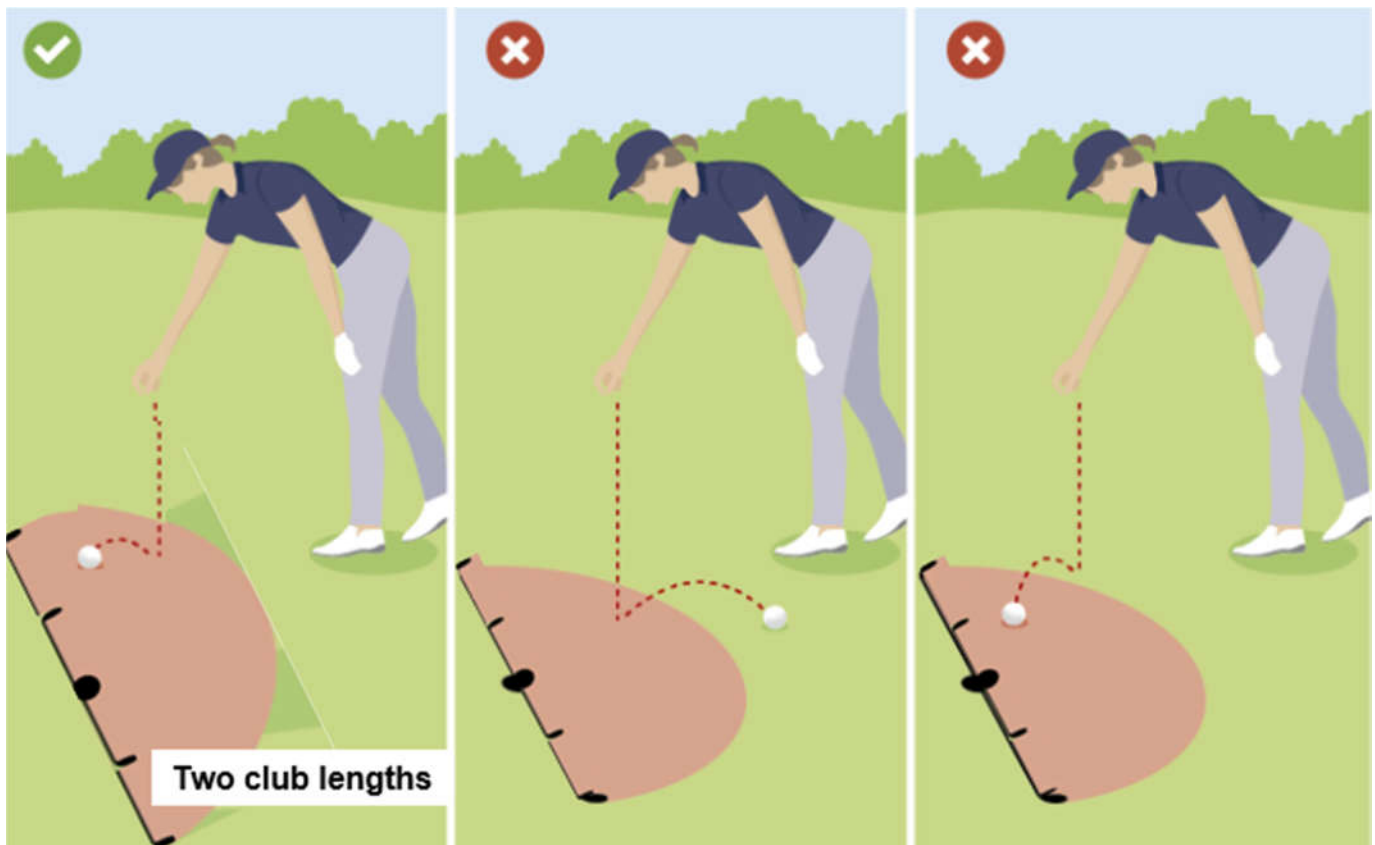
Staked trees – Trees under two metres high – Xanthorrhoea (Black Boys) – Mulched areas under other trees (must be a built-up garden).

A two-club length drop may be taken without penalty.

Golf Rule Section 14

14.3 Dropping Ball in Relief Area

- a Original Ball or Another Ball May Be Used
- b Ball Must Be Dropped in Right Way
- c Ball Dropped in Right Way Must Come to Rest in Relief Area



What to do if ball dropped right way comes to rest outside relief area.

If a ball comes to rest outside the relief area, the player must drop a ball in the right way a second time.

If that ball also comes to rest outside the relief area, the player must place a ball on the spot where the second ball first touched the ground.
