#### SUGGESTION BOX SUMMARY

The suggestion box has been in place now for nearly 12 months.

During that time we have received 15 submissions.

5x actual suggestions,

5x general questions (1x signed), and

5x attacks on the committee (2x names provided).

Most submissions were on scrap bits of paper, coasters or torn pieces of score cards.

12 were anonymous,

1 was signed but still unidentifiable, and

2 provided a name and were able to be dealt with quickly.

The Suggestions x5 (two were duplicate so effectively 4 suggestions received)

Suggested we avoid double up of prizes when a player wins two events eg. drink cups.

Done and dealt with as seen at the 2025 Presentation night.

Suggested sand buckets for golfers and sand boxes on tees.

Noosa Hills Par 3 management issue which they were not in favour of for some reason. Good Idea though!

Suggested a seeded draw off the 1st tee for finalists in Championships/Mug and Ambrose Final.

Once again a good idea and looked at closely. Unfortunately our limited number of 1st tee times and disruption to many of our members would make this hard to adopt. We would expect major issues with this but happy to discuss directly with the member who put the suggestion forward.

2 suggested we change booking process where names are entered first then select a tee time.

A good thought but we would actually end up with the same problem but just a different way of getting there. This would also dramatically increase the instances of double booked times.

Our system has been investigated by previous and new committee members over the years with no practical way of solving

the issue other than spending more \$\$\$ than we can afford. Happy also to discuss this further directly with the members that put that suggestion forward.
